Avoca District 37 PTC Minutes November 13, 2019 Parent Teacher Council Meeting 7:00 pm

PTC President Dorothy opened meeting at 7:02 pm.

- I. Budget and Finances
 - A. Vote approved budget change for Safe Route to Schools
 - 1. Last year's budget approval was for \$6,000 paid this fiscal year and \$6,000 paid next fiscal year.
 - 2. Voting for PTC to pay the total \$12,000 in this fiscal year's budget and then repaid by IL.
 - a) Change in budget because most of the work needs to be done this year.
 - b) Will still have \$40,000 in reserves.
 - c) Ann Heinz moved to vote; Melissa Schiffman seconded motion; vote passed with a majority.
 - B. Innovation Grant / Paypal
 - 1. Approximately \$1,500 in donations collected thus far.
 - 2. Paypal is on the website and working.
 - 3. Susan Lovell to put the link to paypal for donations in the newsletter.
 - 4. Paypal's fee of 2.9% to be discussed at a later date.
 - C. Spirit-wear
 - 1. Approximately \$800 collected thus far.
 - D. Incorporation progress
 - 1. Application for sales tax exemption has been submitted (helpful when purchasing things for Fun Fair this year).
 - 2. 501c3 status on hold due to problems with the lawyer. Dorothy to follow-up with the lawyer.
 - a) 501c3 status gives tax benefits to those who donate.
- II. District Update (Kaine Osburn)
 - A. Evaluating the continuum of services from the district by:
 - 1. Parent surveys at the intercultural dinner on Friday (11/15)
 - a) To see how to delve deeper on diversity in the district (how to go beyond the intercultural dinner).
 - b) To evaluate how well the district is providing and delivering services, especially to those who might have a cultural barrier.
 - 2. Staff self-evaluations
 - 3. Presentation of the evaluation responses to the board in early January.
 - B. Viking fund has raised \$10,000.
 - 1. Strategizing how to best communicate to families in need that the funds are available for use.
 - a) Post on facebook page.

 - 2. Haven Youth and Family Services has also done a session on cyber-bullying this year and will do one on Vaping, and another one on Anxiety and Depression later in the year.

 - 2. Discussed holding the event in a larger room next year possibly NT West's cafeteria.
- C. Movie Night
 - 1. Supposed to be on 12/5 but now finding a later date in January.
 - 2. Possibly trying for Saturday or Sunday afternoon around 5pm.
 - 3. Dorothy and Melanie to find a date and get approval by the school.
 - 4. Dorothy to approve the movie list before 3rd grade votes.

IV. Updates

- A. Marie Murphy VP update:
 - 1. Teacher gifts
 - a) \$2,225 collected thus far.
 - b) Will send out another communication after the holidays.
 - 2. Operation Live Happy (formerly called Snowflake)
 - a) Have a chairperson.
 - b) Will send out an email to 7th grade parents asking for donations and volunteers.
 - c) PTC's budget allocates \$800 for food for this event.
- B. Membership
